

NM State Trauma Registry Case Definition-Inclusion/Exclusion Criteria

All patients must have a primary diagnosis of trauma with at least one injury ICD-9 of 800.00 - 959.9 AND at least one of the following:

- Patient admitted to hospital; and/or
- Patient transferred from or into one acute care facility to another acute care facility; and/or
- Patient dead on arrival or died while in hospital

AND not meet exclusion criteria when the only diagnosis is the following:

- Injury caused by pre-existing condition, e.g. osteoporosis (fracture); esophageal stricture (choking)
- Injuries greater than 30 days old (**Late Effects**) {905.0-909.9}
- Superficial injuries {910.0-924.9}
Foreign bodies (not injuries & non-codable) {930-939}
- Poisoning and toxic events (960.0-989.9)
- Submersion injuries(994.1)
- Strangulation/asphyxiation/anoxic brain death (994.7)
- Electrocution (994.8)
- Overexertion injuries (994.5)
